

LSTM Online MSc Global Health –

Fees & Funding

The fees below refer to entry in the 2024-25 academic year for the MSc Global Health.

Fees are subject to annual review and may be paid in one of two ways:

Either: Pay in Full before course commencement

Master's (180 credits)	£13,800
Postgraduate Diploma (120 credits)	£ 9,200
Postgraduate Certificate (60 credits)	£ 4,600

Or: pay the initial course deposit, with the remainder of your fees to be split into manageable payments – see below:

The above figures have been rounded up to the nearest penny. Students will not pay more than their main final award fee + instalment fee.

How to pay

All fees must be paid in pounds sterling (GBP) directly to LSTM via our payment portal – Flywire - <https://payment.flywire.com/pay/payment>

Other costs

In addition to the fees payable to LSTM, MSc students who are carrying out a project may also need to budget for travel expenses or consumables, depending on the type of project undertaken.

I've done a standalone module – can I use my credits towards an award?

If you have completed a LSTM stand-alone module(s) with assessment and wish to transfer these to a LSTM Award (PgCert / PgDip / MSc) – the cost already incurred will be subtracted from the Award Fee. Students must complete the award within the prescribed registration period. Please email mylstm@lstmed.ac.uk

For example, a student has completed 1 module with assessments and currently holds 20 credits from a core module. The student has decided to register for the PgCert in Global Health and will complete the other two core modules. Previous tuition fee paid will be subtracted from the registered award fee.
