

LSTM MSc Global Health – Fees & Funding

The fees below refer to the 2019-20 academic year for the MSc Global Health.

Fees are subject to annual review and may be paid in one of two ways:

Either: on initial registration, a single payment covering the course registration fee and all module fees

Master's (180 credits)	£12,000
Postgraduate Diploma (120 credits)	£ 9,480
Postgraduate Certificate (60 credits)	£ 6,960

Or: pay the initial course registration fee, plus the fee for each module you are taking in the first year. Then, in subsequent years, you pay the fee for each new module you take. All payments must be received before starting any module.

The above figures have been rounded up to the nearest penny. Students will not pay more than their main final award fee.

Individual modules (taken on a stand-alone basis with no registration fee). There are options to do the stand-alone module for CPD or for Academic Credit (subject to a £95 assessment fee)

How to pay

All fees must be paid in pounds sterling (GBP) directly to LSTM via our payment portal – Flywire - <https://payment.flywire.com/pay/payment>

Other costs

In addition to the fees payable to LSTM, MSc students who are carrying out a project may also need to budget for travel expenses or consumables, depending on the type of project undertaken.

I've done a standalone module – can I use my credits towards an award?

If you have completed a stand-alone module(s) with assessment and wish to transfer these to a LSTM Award (PgCert / PgDip / MSc) – the cost already incurred will be subtracted from the Award Fee. Students must complete the award within the prescribed registration period. Please email mylstm@lstmed.ac.uk

For example, a student has completed 1 module with assessments and currently holds 20 credits from a core module. The student has decided to register for the PgCert in Global Health and will complete the other two core modules. Previous tuition fee paid was £2,000 + 95 = £2095. This amount is subtracted from the PgCert Fee: £6,960 - £2,095 = £4,865 remaining to pay.
